The minimum duration of 6 Semesters can be reduced to 4 Semesters in special cases on the basis of years of schooling, length of teaching / research experience, number of publications, etc on the recommendation of the Supervisory Committee.

Dissertation will be evaluated by at least two experts from technologically advanced foreign countries and acceptance / publication of at least one research paper in any of the Indexed Journals. There will be a public defense of the student's research work.
